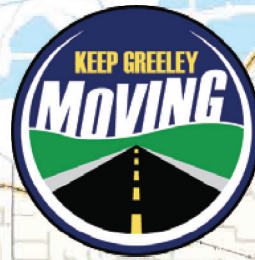


KEEP GREELEY MOVING 2016



In 2015, Greeley voters approved a tax increase of 0.65% (excluding food for home consumption) to fund street improvements, road capacity projects, and concrete repair.



The tax has a seven year life which started January 1, 2016 and "sunssets" on December 31, 2022.



The 0.65% additional tax will generate \$9.4 million annually.



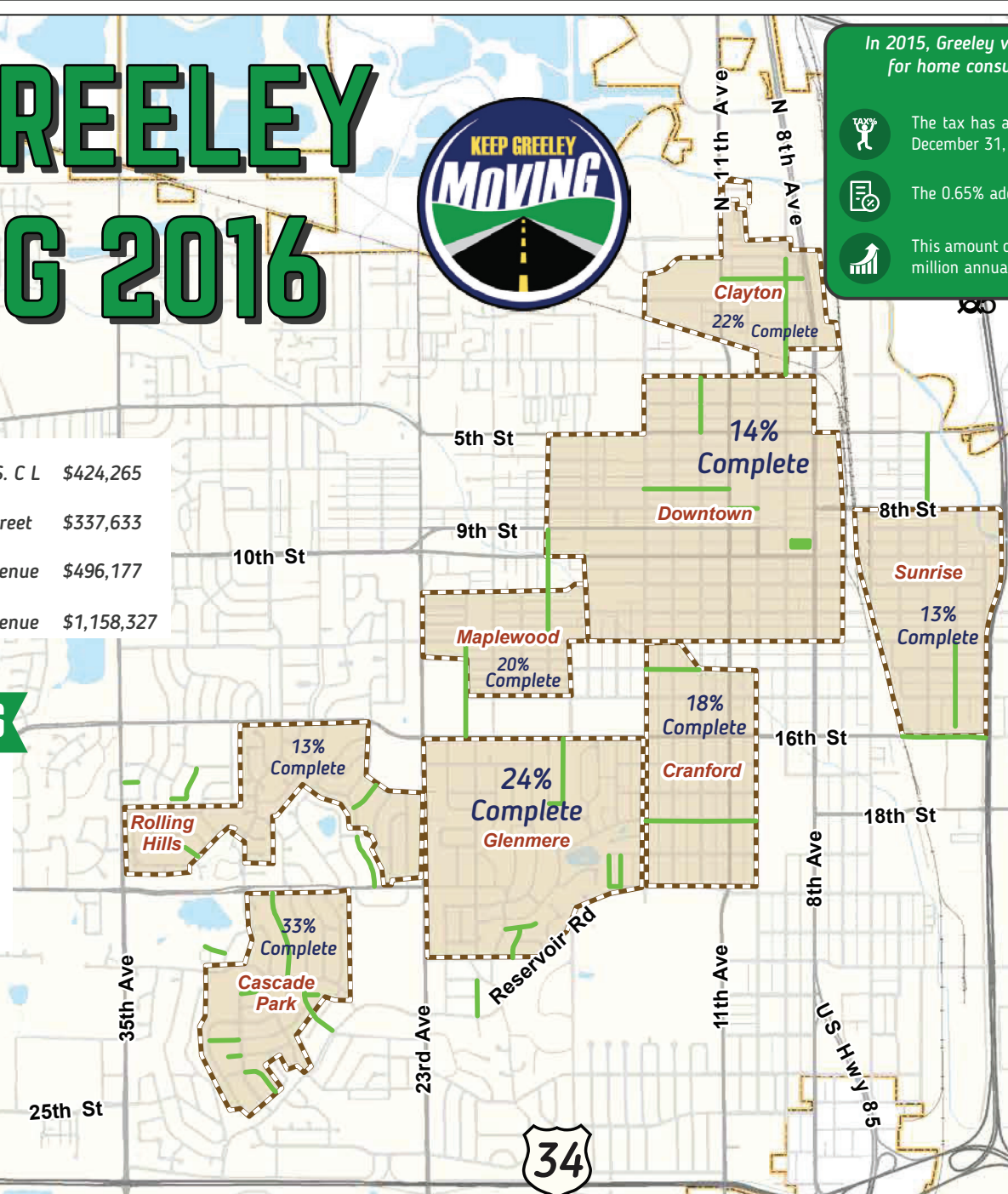
This amount combined with \$2.6 million from food tax revenue will provide \$12 million annually for road improvements.

- 2019-2021 - 35th Avenue: 4th to "F" Street-\$9,080,000
